

# **Statement of Purpose**

## Aims and objectives

We provide ear care services, which includes microsuction for ear wax removal, foreign body removal and ear infection treatment.

The service is for anyone from 2 years old and is delivered by ear, nose and throat (ENT) doctors.

We comply with the Care Quality Commission (CQC) Regulations 2009 and the Health and Social Care Act 2008 (Regulated Activities) Regulations 2014.

#### **Healthcare services**

Auris Ear Care provides an independent healthcare service in the form of the following regulated activity:

Treatment of disease, disorder or injury.

The service includes consultations by ENT doctors, physical examinations and health assessments relating to the ear, microsuction of ear wax, foreign body removal from the external auditory canal, ear infection treatment (Otitis Externa), prescribing of medicines and referrals to other healthcare specialists when necessary.

## **CQC** service types

CQC service types are doctor consultation service (DCS), doctor treatment service (DTS) and mobile doctor service (MBS).

Auris Ear Care provides consultations by appointment only, subject to medical assessment. During a consultation, a patient history will be taken and patients are advised of the proposed treatment and fees prior to proceeding.
